

## **Grade 4: Habitats and Communities Food Chain Assignment and Assessment**

Assignment: Students will create their own food chain similar to that of the teacher's. The students will string their food chains together to form a hanging food chain.

Requirements:

- Students will create one food chain that is a minimum of 5 levels.
- Food chain must be in correct order, with the final subject at the top.
- Each level will be a cut out and coloured representation of the subject of that level. For example if the subject of the level is the sun, then the shape will be a round and yellow representation of the sun.
- On the back of each shape the student will write a few short sentences about the subject, making sure to use any related terms from the worksheet. For example, a cow is a herbivore.
- Writing must be neat and legible, or the information is to be typed.
